FADE IN:

EXT. LOW-INCOME APARTMENT BUILDING IN LONG BEACH - NIGHT

TIGHT ON AN UPSIDE DOWN TV SCREEN: A ruggedly handsome, PLEASANTLY DEPRESSED MAN in a flannel shirt strolls a leafy wood. **Everything is upside down.**

PLEASANTLY DEPRESSED MAN (CONT'D)  
But I'm just not where I want to be  
with my depression symptoms.

The Man looks proudly toward the horizon.

MEDICAL V.O.  
If your antidepressant alone isn't  
enough, talk to your doctor about  
adding Abilify.

An upside down FAWN runs playfully through the foliage.

PLEASANTLY DEPRESSED MAN  
(breaking into a smile)  
With Abilify, I've got a shot at  
brighter future.

The Fawn watches as the Man SKIPS STONES across a pond. Each ripple on the water is a ripple of hope.

MEDICAL V.O.  
Use caution when using Abilify as  
some patients may experience  
drastic changes in mood, behavior  
and/or thoughts of suicide. Abilify  
is not meant for children,  
adolescents and young adults.  
Elderly patients may have an  
increased risk of dementia or  
stroke. Call your doctor if you  
have high fevers, uncontrollable  
muscle movements and/or confusion  
as these may be symptoms of a  
potentially life threatening  
reaction.

MEDICAL V.O. (CONT'D)

High blood sugar has also been reported on Abilify, in some extreme cases leading to coma or death. Other risks include dizziness, seizures, impaired motor skills, trouble swallowing and instantaneous bowel movements.

TEAGUE (V.O.)

I wrote that...

PULL BACK SLOWLY: Our UPSIDE DOWN VIEW is through the window of a top floor apartment in a low income high rise.

TEAGUE (V.O.)

Not the baby deer part -- which in my opinion is a little heavy-handed -- but the part with the disclaimer o' death. It's an important job...

REVERSE ANGLE: TEAGUE WESTERBERG, 29, tall, pretty, a former division-three collegiate volleyball player, now approximately 8-14 pounds overweight (depending on the scale). She watches TV outside the window, her hair standing straight up, a few strands stuck to her BLOOD-SPLATTERED face. Her pantsuit jacket dangles behind her like a cape.

TEAGUE (V.O.)

It's important to be aware of the risks...

CAMERA does a 180, turning the world RIGHT SIDE UP, revealing Teague HANGING UPSIDE DOWN off the roof of the building.

TEAGUE (V.O.)

To know exactly what you're getting yourself into.

A shaky, white-knuckled HAND grips Teague by the ankle.

MALE VOICE (O.S.)

NOOO!

The Hand releases and Teague free-falls...

TEAGUE

AHHHHHH!

FREEZE FRAME as a she flails in mid-air.

TEAGUE (V.O.)  
If life came with disclaimers, I  
think we'd all be a lot happier.

UNFREEZE. Teague plummets out of frame. A loud CRASH! BLACK  
OUT.
